ORDER

In accordance with the memorandum opinion entered this day, it is hereby ORDERED that defendants' motion to dismiss (Dkt. No. 51.) is GRANTED. Accordingly, all claims are DISMISSED:

- 1. As to the due process claims (Counts I, II, and III),
 - a. these claims against James Madison University are DISMISSED WITHOUT
 PREJUDICE; and
 - b. all official-capacity claims for money damages against Amy Sirocky-Meck, Robert Aguirre, and Heather Coltman are DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE, but all official-capacity claims for prospective injunctive relief and all individualcapacity claims against these defendants are DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE.
- 2. Title IX Claims against all defendants are DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE but with leave to amend; and
- All claims against all John and Jane Doe defendants are DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.

Plaintiff has thirty (30) days in which to file any amended complaint asserting only Title IX claims.

The Clerk shall send a copy of this order and the memorandum opinion to counsel of record.
