JOINT NOTICE IN RESPONSE TO COURT ORDER

On October 4, 2023, the Court remanded this case to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) for the limited purpose of permitting the agency to vacate the final agency decision under review. The Court ordered the parties to file a notice "within five days of final agency action taken pursuant to this limited remand" and to "either (1) notify the court whether additional proceedings in this court will be necessary, or (2) file any appropriate motion regarding the continuation of proceedings in this court." Order, No. 23-9564 (Oct. 4, 2023).

On November 2, 2023, the FMCSA vacated the final agency order at issue in this litigation. As the parties noted in the joint motion for a limited remand and the
